For 17 years **Rabbi Yitzchak** immersed himself in study 20 hours a day with Jerusalem's leading Kabbalists. 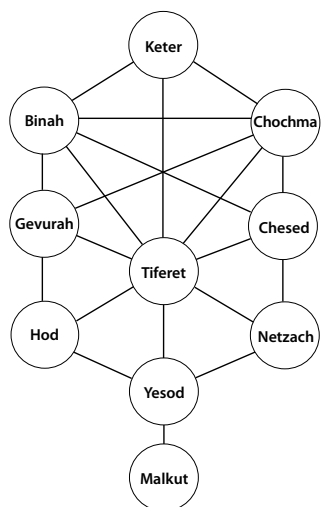

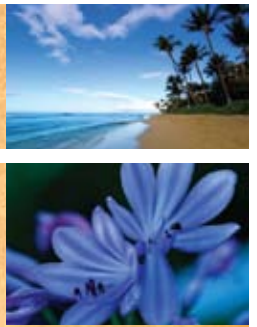
